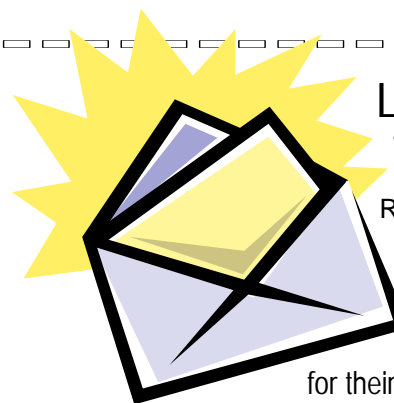

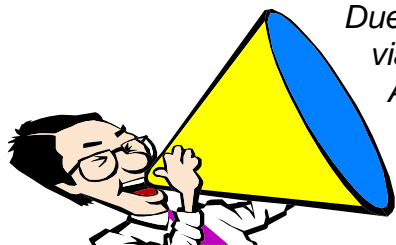
**Go-Carting at Emberton Park

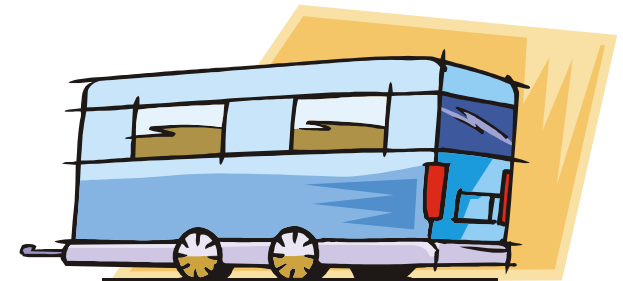
