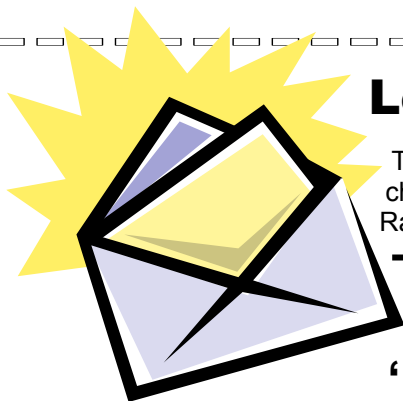

JUDGING

An approved Wine Judge should be obtained to judge this event.

ENTRY DATE.

Entries on the day with the appropriate fee as set by Committee. Each bottle to be clearly marked with a number, a record of which to be given to the entrant.

GENERAL RULES

Wine

Should be in a clear bottle with a push in removable cork and clearly labelled with the wine entry class and no other details.

Failure to comply will result in points being deducted, or in some cases at the judge's discretion, disqualification of the entry.

Beer

Should be in a dark bottle and labelled Lager, Bitter or Brown according to type.

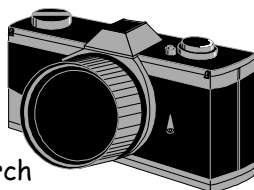
