Centre Equipment




From the Birthday Boy...



VICTORIA SPONGE

(Must be cooked in the Caravan/Motorhome)

ENTRY CLASS

Open to all registered Full, Joint and Family members of the Bedfordshire Centre. A First, Second and Third will be selected. The winning Victoria Sponge will be awarded the Gilks Trophy.

Ingredients:

- 100 grams soft margarine
- 100 grams self raising flour
- 100 grams caster sugar
- 2 medium size eggs
- 2 tablespoons of jam

Method:

- Pre-heat the oven Gas Mark 5 and grease, flour and line two 7" cake tins.
- Sieve the flour on to a plate. Beat the eggs in a small bowl.
- Cream the margarine & sugar together until they are light and fluffy. USE A WOODEN SPOON.
- Add a small amount of egg and one teaspoon of flour to the creamed mixture and beat well. Add the rest of the egg a little at a time, beating well after each addition.
- Add the remaining flour to the mixture and fold in using a METAL SPOON.
- Divide the mixture equally between the two tins and spread it level.
- Cook in the oven for approximately 20 minutes or until the cake is firm to the touch.
- When cool, sandwich together with jam and serve on a plate with a doily.




The Chocolate Rabbit


