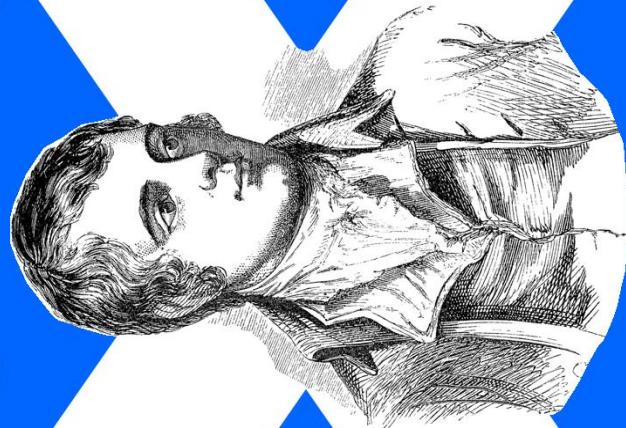

The Olympic Games are over for another four years and probably not to be held again in this country in our life time. It was a privilege to be a "Games Maker" to be selected out of the 240,000 that applied to be and end up as one of the 65,000 supporting the games. I completed 24 shifts of 10 hours over the Olympics & Paralympics I was based in the Olympic Park, by the main stadium at the fleet depot, and my role was a T3 driver driving one of the Olympic BMW's during the main Olympics then driving either a WAV vehicle (Wheelchair Access Vehicle) or a 7 seater mini bus to transfer committee members from the Olympic Park to wherever they needed to go, either to another Olympic venue or back to their hotel. Some shifts were busier than others and using the Olympic lanes around London was a great help in the rush hour traffic, which seemed to be most of the day and extend to the middle of the night! I met a wide range of people and different nationalities and a great team of fellow drivers. I have some great memories of my time working there, also got to know most of the roads round London and how to take some short cuts to miss the traffic queues. When we had finished all our shift we all got presented with an engraved baton from the Olympics along with our bronze, silver & gold games maker badges

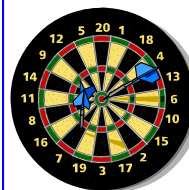

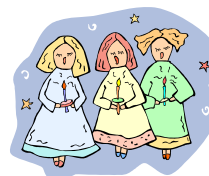
